



Extended Schools Information Pack

At Whitehall Park School, we aim to offer children a wide range of fun and exciting Extended School activities outside of core school hours. These are:

- **Breakfast Club** – runs from Monday to Friday during term-time from 7.45-8.45am (no admission after 8.30am) **Breakfast** is provided
- **Après School Clubs** – run from Monday to Friday during term-time from 3.30-5.00pm and include specialist provision in a number of areas (see below). Children are taken to the dining hall at 3.30pm and provided a **snack** in advance of the 4pm session
- **Twilight Time** – runs from Monday to **Thursday** during term-time 5.00-6.00pm. A further **snack** is provided. Twilight Time can only be booked with an Après School Club on the same day.

Après School Clubs

Après School Clubs are limited by year group and number of places available. Some clubs are more popular, e.g. fencing, ballet, street dance, football and archery, so there may be disappointment if your child wants one of these. Some clubs may not be appropriate for your child, i.e. Advanced French will not be appropriate if your child does not know basic French. A description of the Clubs, number of places available and applicable year groups is set out below.



APRES SCHOOL CLUBS

ADVANCED FRENCH – Les Coccinelles – 15 places on Thursday for Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 £11.00

These lessons are designed for those children who already speak French at home and will involve reading, written and oral work with an emphasis on grammar, spelling and learning new vocabulary.

ARCHERY – Supersports – 20 places on Friday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £8.50

Archery is a low impact gateway sport that is both physically and mentally challenging. The benefits from archery include improving mental capacity, physical health and general fitness. Archery can also improve patience and focus and can give the student a strong sense of personal achievement. Weather appropriate PE kit is required for your child to take part in this club as it will be outside come rain or shine.

ARTS & CRAFTS

Extended Schools Team – 25 places on Tuesday for Reception and Year 1, 25 places on Monday for Years 1 and 2 £7.50

Suzanne Asphall – 24 places on Monday for Years 3 and 4 £8.50

The club will offer the children an experience and enjoyment in aspects of art and design, e.g. painting, papier-mache, collage, textiles and 3-D modelling. Children will be encouraged to express themselves and to be creative in a relaxed environment.

BALLET – Maria Tennant £10.50

20 places on Thursday for Years 1 and 2

20 places on Wednesday for Years 3 and 4

These dance lessons will involve exploring space, rhythm and musicality. This will be combined with basic ballet movements to help with confidence and the enjoyment of dance. Let your child shine and learn how to improve balance, coordination and performance while dancing beautiful movements of ballet. Creative variations are combined with technique, posture exercises and great music.

CAPOEIRA CLUB – Hiram Ribeiro – 20 places on Tuesday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £12.00

Capoeira is great fun for children. It helps with co-ordination, balance, agility, flexibility, fun, aerobic fitness and so many other aspects related to having fun and keeping fit!

FENCING – FightingFitFencing – 15 places on Wednesday for Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 £11.00

Fencing has proven to improve flexibility, reflex, focus, concentration and the nimbleness of hands and feet. It also boosts mental strength and concentration. Fencing can provide a fun way to stay fit or get in shape. Enhancing integrity, sportsmanship and the desire to excel. Fencing also hones strategic thinking and decision-making skills.

FILM CLUB – Extended Schools Team – 30 places on Friday for All Years Groups £7.50

Kick back and enjoy a film along with some popcorn. A perfect end to the week!

FOOTBALL – Sam Ruff £8.50

20 places on Friday for Years 1 and 2

20 places on Monday for Years 3 and 4

There are so many benefits of playing football, one of the main ones being to increase their levels of fitness and to teach them the importance of exercise. It is also great for promoting confidence and the ability to work together as a team, transferable skills that they will continue to use and build upon throughout their lives. Weather appropriate PE kit is required for your child to take part in this club as it will be outside come rain or shine.



FRENCH – Claire Murat – 15 places on Wednesday for Years 1 and 2 £10.50

I use a fun approach to develop linguistic skills, introducing the children to the language and culture through games, stories and songs. I also aim to encourage a positive and open attitude to learning languages in general.

ITALIAN CLUB – Miss Angela-15 places on Tuesday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £10.50

MULTI-SPORTS – Supersports – 24 places on Thursday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £8.50

Multi-sports is an excellent starting point for a child's involvement in sport. Weather appropriate PE kit is required for your child to take part in this club as it will be outside come rain or shine.

MUSICAL THEATRE – Sarah Spiers – 30 places on Thursday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £7.50

We are the all singing, dancing and acting club! In Musical Theatre club we will be learning how to warm up our voices and play games to develop our acting skills so that we can get into our character's role. We will be learning a variety of songs from our favourite musicals and putting dance moves together. There will be plenty of opportunities for children to develop and create their own ideas as well.

PERFORMING ARTS – Hannah from Little Supernovas £8.50

20 places on Thursday for Reception and Year 1

30 places on Tuesday for Years 2, 3 and 4

Let your child's imagination explode with a different action adventure each week! They'll travel to mystical lands, boogie with baboons, tickle an octopus or even blast off into space. Just about anywhere our imaginations take us! Our classes incorporate action, storytelling, music, props, drama, movement, games and plenty of giggles!!

PREP CLUB – Extended Schools Team – 15 places on Wednesday for Years 2, 3 and 4 £7.50

This is a project based learning club where children can work independently or collaboratively in choosing a topic to research, using various mediums such as iPads, books or newspapers culminating in a fact file, Power Point presentation or a talk to their classmates.

PUZZLE CLUB – Extended Schools Team – 20 places on Tuesday for Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 £7.50

This club involves children playing games, puzzles and other challenging activities to stimulate their thinking. This club will help children improve their resilience and cooperative skills, as well as being a lot of fun!

SPANISH – Patricia Ibarra £10.50

15 places on Monday for Years 1 and 2

Learning a language can be lots of fun. Why choose Spanish as your new foreign language? It is the second most spoken language in the world! Children will be exposed to the Spanish language and culture in a relaxed and fun environment. Your child will pick up the Spanish language really easily and will be very enthusiastic about the progress that they are making! They will benefit from games, music, role-play, storytelling, competitions and visual aids that will give them real opportunities to show off their new skills.

STAY & PLAY – Extended Schools Team £7.50

25 places on Monday for Reception and Year 1

25 places on Wednesday for All Year Groups

This club is intended to ease the younger members of our Whitehall Park family into the Après School Club setting with lots of children led play full of fun and games such as Lego, puzzles, drawing etc. Most children literally have to be dragged away!

STREET DANCE – AJ – 16 places on Monday for Years 3 and 4 £10.50

Using a variety of music, students of all ages can expect to increase their strength, fitness, flexibility, balance and self-awareness in our fantastic new Street Dance classes. In addition to the physical benefits, dance offers the opportunity for students to develop important life skills such as self-confidence, motivation, independence and team work in an environment that is safe, engaging and enjoyable.

TAG RUGBY – Supersports – 24 places on Tuesday for Years 1, 2 and 3 £8.50

Tag Rugby is a non-contact sport in which each player wears a belt with two Velcro tags attached to it. The mode of play is based on normal rugby with players attempting to dodge, evade and pass a rugby ball while defenders attempt to prevent them scoring by “Tagging”- pulling a Velcro attached tag from the ball carrier, rather than full contact tackle. Weather appropriate PE kit is required for your child to take part in this club as it will be outside come rain or shine.

Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit for all sporting after school clubs and that it is weather appropriate. We always recommend that a child keep their PE kit in school each week, bringing it in Monday and taking it home on Friday to be washed ready for the following week.
