Autumn 1 – All about me

This unit provides children with opportunities to examine aspects of their own lives including:-

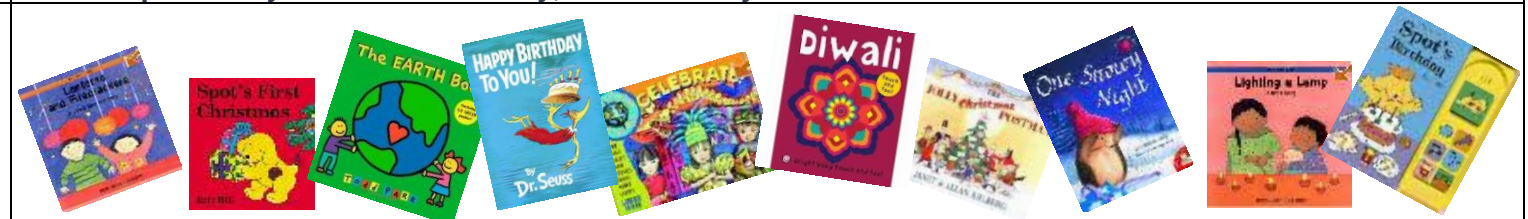
- Growing up – from being a baby to now

- Favourite things – including toys, books, friends, other people
- My senses – finding out about the world around them



Autumn 2 – All that Glitters

In our Autumn unit, we will focus upon a wide range of celebrations that children experience in their lives and use materials to help us make sense of them:-

- Materials – learning about different materials and their properties
- Celebrations within our families – birthdays, christenings, weddings
- Religious celebrations – Christmas, Diwali, Chinese Moon festival, Ramadan, Eid
- Traditions – Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Harvest
- Special days – World Food day, Black History month

Spring 1 – Under the Sea

In the Spring term, we will find out about our oceans learning about sea creatures and pirates :-

- Pirates and treasure – Ahoy Me Hearties! Let's find treasure by sailing across the deep blue sea!
- The deep blue – what habitats do the sea animals have? What do they eat?
- Saving our sea – how can we be sustainable? What can we do to help our oceans? How can we save water?



Spring 2 – Into Space

In this unit, we will be going on a Space adventure on our Magic rocket to find out about all sorts of exciting things:-

- Planets – what are the names of the planets? How far away are they? What would it be like to live on a different one?
- Aliens – what would it be like to meet an alien? What adventures would you go on with an alien?
- We will also explore the difference between fact and fiction text.

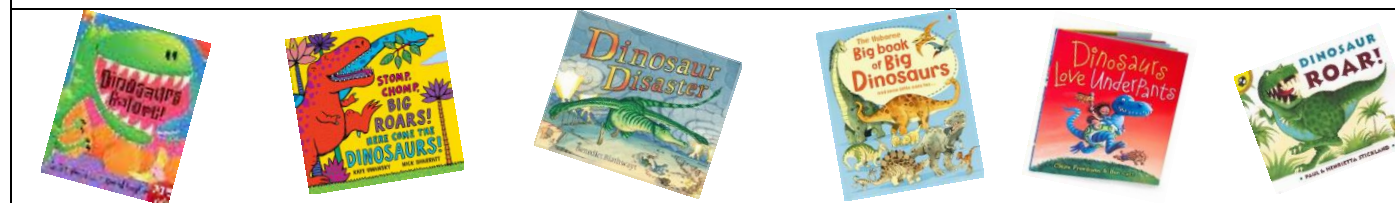


Changes!

Summer 1 – A Dinosaur Invasion!

In our final half term, we are going to be looking to the past to help us to understand the future:-

- Dinosaurs – Following on from our topic looking at facts about space and pirates, we will explore the mega-beasts by digging up the past in a hunt for dinosaurs
- We will learn about volcanoes and other natural phenomena in order to explore how and why dinosaurs are now extinct
