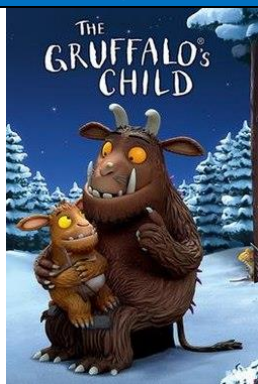


## English

What might it look like? Have a go describing it and get an adult to write it down. Why is your creature so terrible?

## Topic

Can you explain how to make Gruffalo crumble to someone at home? Draw pictures of the ingredients we used, you can have a go at labelling them.



## Phonics and Handwriting

Every week in phonics we will learn new sounds. These may be phonemes. Practise your sounds at home. Your adult can google the 'Set 1' sounds we learn in 'Read Write Inc' or find them in your reading record.

## Reading

It is suggested that children in Reception should read for a minimum of **15 minutes** every day including Saturday and Sunday.



Can you ask your child:  
What happened so far?  
What might happen next?  
What is your favourite page in the book and why?  
*Remember your child's reading record should be in school every day.*

## Maths

Work out these addition number sentences:

$$2 + 3 =$$

$$4 + 2 =$$

$$3 + 4 =$$

Try copying the number sentence first. Next, draw dots (or use objects) for each group and write down the total. It should look something like this:

$$\begin{array}{|c|} \hline \cdot \\ \hline \end{array} + \begin{array}{|c|} \hline \cdot \\ \hline \end{array} = \boxed{5}$$

For a challenge, try working out your own number sentences, get your adult to help you!
