Securing Multiplication Facts

Identify and explore patterns in multiplication tables including 7 and 9

History

Anglo Saxons

The children will examine the Impact of the Anglo Saxons on modern society.

We will discuss the following questions:

- Who were the Anglo Saxons and where did they come from?
- What was life like during the Anglo Saxon period?
- What was the significance of Christianity and religion?
- Who were the famous kings?

English

Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo

The epic Anglo-Saxon legend is brilliantly recreated by an award-winning author/illustrator team. In fifth-century Denmark, a murderous monster stalks the night, and only the great prince of the Geats has the strength and courage to defeat him.

Krindlekrax by Philip Ridley

An urban myth creature challenges two boys in competition for a part in the school play. Ruskin Splinter is small and thin, with knock-knees, thick glasses and a squeaky voice, and the idea of him taming a dragon makes the whole class laugh. Big, strong Elvis is stupid but he looks like a hero. So who is more likely to get the big part in the school play?

Dreams and Goals

In this terms topic, children will be focussing on their hopes and dreams: putting the steps in place on how to achieve these and reflecting when things do not go quite as planned.

D&T

Cooking & Nutrition – Healthy Snack Bars

The children will explore the world of healthy snack bars before designing and making their own.

RE

Why do some people think that life is a journey? What significant experiences mark this?

This investigation enables pupils to learn in depth from different religious and spiritual ways of life relating to milestones on the journey of life. Through exploring baptism, Bar and Bat Mitzvah or Hindu Samskaras and marriage pupils explore how and why people chose to mark significant moments in life.

Science

Chemistry - States of Matter

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.
