

Consultation on Whitehall Park School Admissions Policy 2023-24

Background:

Whitehall Park School opened in 2015 as a two-form entry school serving the community of Whitehall Park, Islington and families from Archway and Haringey, London. There have not been any changes to the schools Admissions Policy since creation in 2015. As such under the Schools Admissions Code, Bellevue Place Education Trust (BPET), as the admissions authority, must consult when admission arrangements as they have not been consulted on within the last 7 years. Admission authorities must consult for a minimum period of 6 weeks between 1 October and 31 January.

Who is consulted:

This consultation is for the attention of:

- Parents/Carers of children currently at the school
- School staff
- School LAB (Local Advisory Board)
- Pre-school and primary school providers
- Islington Borough Council
- Haringey Borough Council

Responses:

This consultation ran 6 December 2021 until 20 January 2022. All groups consulted were invited to submit comments in writing about the Whitehall Park School 2023-24 Admissions Policy to Tracey Blandford, Marketing Manager, Bellevue Place Education Trust (BPET) c/o Kilburn Grange School, Priory Park Road, Kilburn, LONDON NW6 7UJ, by midday on 20 January 2022 or by email to info@BPET.co.uk.

There was one response from the Hornsey Lane Estate Community Association, confirming they were happy with the policy proposed and no further comment.

Conclusion:

The BPET Board has agreed the proposed 2023-24 Admissions Policy as the determined arrangements for Whitehall Park School. These are now available on the School Website and are contained in a 'latest news' post on the BPET website, alongside other schools in the Trust who undertook a similar consultation process. The policy as "MASTER" has now been sent to Islington Council for addition to their website.
