CONSENT FORM FOR CHILD TO BE ALLOWED TO WALK HOME ALONE

Please would you also ensure that if your child has a mobile phone, he/she hands it into the office at the beginning of the day and collects it at the end of the day. No child should have a mobile phone during lesson time and the school cannot accept any responsibility for individual mobile phones not handed in to the office. (If you would like your child to bring their phone to school, please fill in a seperate form)

To safeguard all young people at Whitehall Park School, if you want your child to make his/her own way home from school independently, then we will require written permission from you to confirm the arrangement. Please complete the slip below.
